

Calais School District Trustees
Tuesday, July 23, 2014
Minutes

The Calais School District Trustees met on Tuesday, July 23, 2014 at the Early Childhood Education Building at 5:30 P.M. Present were Chairman, John Smith and Pam Bridges. Also attending were Superintendent Bob Moholland and School Board Chairman John Hill.

Chairman John Smith called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Superintendent Moholland discussed maintenance concerns that he had for the Calais Schools and the high dollar cost for the maintenance. Some of the items noted were:

1. Gym Floor CMS/CHS
2. Bleachers in CMS/CHS Gym
3. Ceiling fans in CMS/CHS Gym
4. Boilers Calais Elementary School
5. Front doors for handicap accessibility – both schools

It was recommended that the Superintendent develop a three to five year maintenance plan with input from School Board, Trustees and Administration.

Superintendent Moholland explained the work that is being done this summer:

1. Siding CMS/CHS
2. Back parking lot CMS/CHS
3. Pot holes Elementary School

He also explained the elementary school windows will be replaced and the budget is short approximately \$11,000.00. He asked the Trustees if the city did not give us the money would they be willing to help. Both members present said that they would. No vote was taken.

Under other business, Superintendent Moholland told the Trustees that he would present a plan to the City Council on August 14, 2014 to repair/replace major expense items within the Calais Schools. He would also ask the City Council to appropriate \$50,000.00 a year to be deposited in the Trustees account to accomplish this.

Motion by Pam Bridges, seconded by John Smith unanimous vote to adjourn at 6:15 p.m.
